**Building Campaign Donation** 

June 20, 2023

Dear Fellow Democrats,

For close to 19 years, we have relied on our wonderful Lincoln County Democratic Headquarters to hold meetings and get us through election cycles. The building has been a positive element in the functioning of our party's efforts. As it is with every building over time, significant structural maintenance is required for its preservation. With protection of the building in mind, the party's Building Committee has obtained estimates to \*replace the roof(\$26,000), \*repair some structural damage in the storage room (\$2,100), \*improve the storage room for optimizing its use to free interior spaces (\$4,000), \*add a security/monitoring system (\$750), and \*repair the side entry roof with metal (\$1,000).

The Finance Committee has set a goal of \$35,000 for these projects based on estimates. The donation levels are as follows: Benefactor - \$5,000; Champion - \$2,500; Patron - \$1,000, Contributor - \$500; Friend - \$250; Donor - \$100; and any other amounts. Donations may be made by you individually, and since the funds benefit the building (not politics), a company check is acceptable. ALL the funds will be used on the building and any funds over the \$35,000 will be deposited in the Building Fund account (separate from the Party account) for smaller repairs in the future.

The Building Committee would like to have all the repairs completed well before the 2024 election cycle which encompasses very important elections from national to state to local so that we may concentrate on getting our candidates elected. We hope you will consider a generous donation to our Democratic Party's iconic headquarters.
